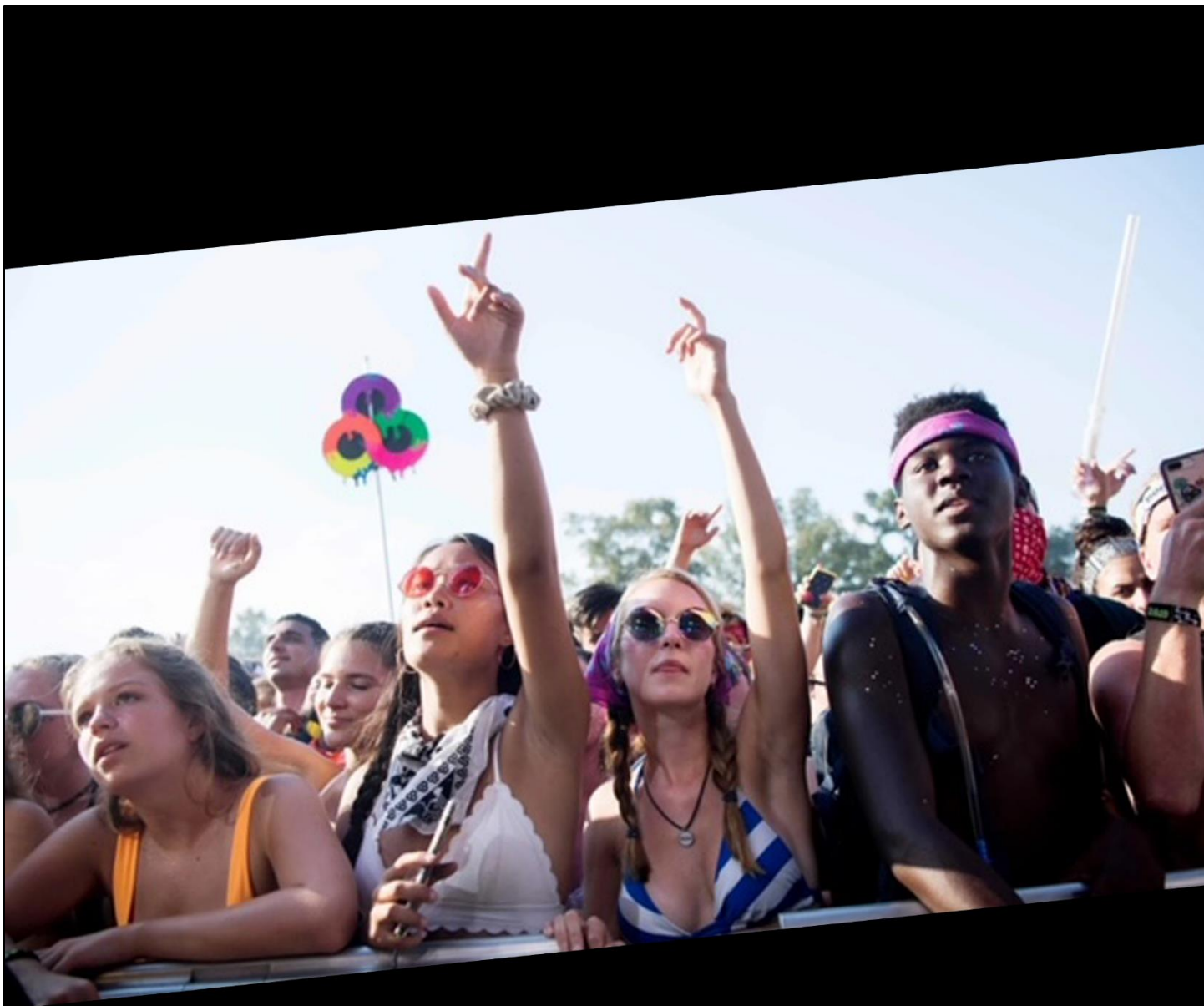
what is **fForest Fest**

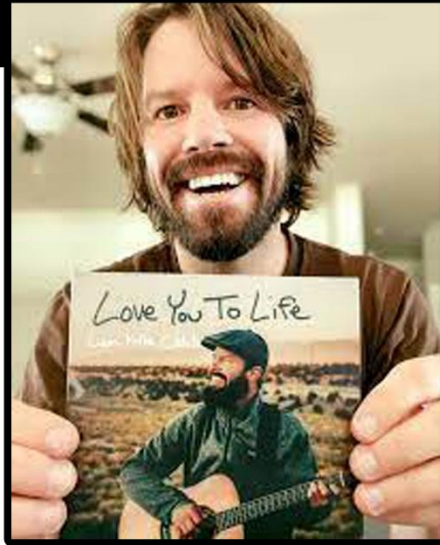

A CLOSER LOOK

FFOREST FEST HEADED TO MORRIS

'A fun family day underneath the trees'

MORRIS — Be, do and make. That's the mantra for a jam-packed family festival filled with multiple vendors, live music, food, crafts and yoga under the trees. fForest Fest will be taking over Gould Park in Morris on Saturday, June 4, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

fForest, the Norwegian spelling for forest, means to make and do outdoors.

"fForest Fest is a fun family day underneath the trees. It's such a beautiful park and we really wanted somebody to do something — we've been talking about it for the last few years. Sometimes you got to take the step and do it yourself," said Stacey Olson, the owner of True North.

This will be the first year the festival will take place. The hope is to help boost tourism in Morris and use an often overlooked space with performers such as The Tossers, The Homeless Gospel Choir, Run Forest Run, Andrew David Weber and Band and Liam Kyle Cahill.

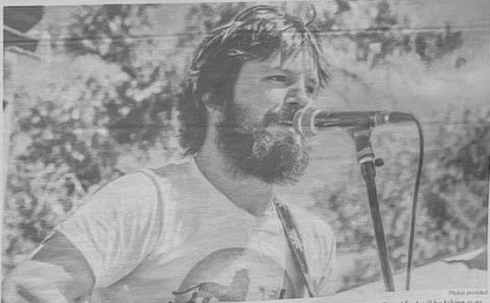
"We decided to do something different with this market. Usually, when you go to a market, you go to shop and call it a day. We decided to add music to keep you there all day long," Olson said.

The Tossers is "Irish drinking music for punk rockers with a twist." The Homeless Gospel Choir is a "folk-punk choir out of Pittsburgh that covers a wide range of topics of social justice and mental health."

Inclusion and the best 90s tribute cover the best 90s tribute covers in the Chicago area. Andrew David Weber and Band are a multi-instrumentalist with a unique voice, best known for their work with Whiskey of the West.

Food trucks will be lined up together to form a food court with other food vendors set up throughout the market. There will be a picnic pavilion set up with seating for guests. Vendors will offer everything from barbecue to hot dogs.

Samantha Smiles will be teaching "yoga under the trees." She will be offering yoga instruction for all levels starting at 10:30 to 11 a.m., with three more classes from 12:30 to 1 p.m., 2:30 to 3 p.m. and 5 to 6:30 p.m.

The tickets are \$6 a person and can be bought through PayPal or in person on the day of the festival.

The festival will offer numerous activities for children of all ages including games, games, games, face painting, crafts and more.

The festival will offer many family friendly events. We have a clown making, balloon animal, we have a build your own Play-Doh station and a kids scavenger hunt," Olson said.

"I am also excited for the folks that do not reside in our city that will be visiting the festival. I hope they discover all that Morris has to offer and come back and see us again soon," he said.

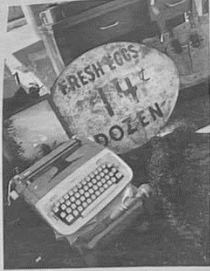

Bad Year



Rooted in Midwest punk rock, Bad Year formed in 2019 and calls Milwaukee home. Inspired by heartbreak, angst, and self-reformation, Bad Year injects the scene with anthemic chorus hooks and brutal optimism. In the spirit of promoting positive aspects of empathy and mental health, their cathartic melodies are known for freely inspiring listeners with a sense of mutual understanding and hope. The group put a fresh, more decorated feel on musical incarnations and lived experiences of the past.

Bad Year's groundbreaking debut EP "Handshakes" received immediate acclaim from listeners and an unmediated Wisconsin Area Music Industry (WAMI) Award nomination while the title track's music video gained over 100k views within its first month. The trio refrained from allowing a pandemic to slow their upbeat tempo with their one-off single "Blackout". Keeping the momentum and expanding boundaries of incendiary music composition, "Blackout" was Bad Year's first production with highly sought-after producer, Nick Rad. Ending 2020 on a high note, "A Moment In Time" EP, was released and creates acoustic landscapes of sound that evoke feelings, energies, and memories.

The recent feeling of shared musical experiences has been sorely missed. With the music community recovering from feeling displaced and longing for connection together, these desires will surely be met by this upcoming release. Born from lived experience and forged from the pandemic, the recent singles Killing Me, Paranoid Failure, and The End have exceeded listeners' expectations. The spankin' new EP and singles like Charcoal Black are no exception. We hope our songs help listeners get through hard times because let's admit it, life sucks sometimes.



BAD YEAR

Expanding our intellectual horizons, shaping relationships, and allowing the lyrical composition process to elegantly represent our experiences are among the endless activities that make us feel alive. Bad Year is not only an outlet for us to express and voice our true emotions that helps heal and improve our lives, but it's a setting where we freely aim our practice to give back to society and help others by making music that others can identify with. As musicians, we hope that our fans experience a sample of the passion and healing that we've experienced through our influences through hard times. We are blessed to continue to have abundant opportunities granted to us and are honored to work together with organizations that promote our shared beliefs. Our goals consist of continuing to share our music in hopes of working together to help spread a love of music, raise mental health awareness, and offer harm reduction and prevention methods to the public. Bad Year is determined to continue spreading love and positivity through our music and friendships.





THICK

Since first forming in 2014, New York trio THICK have triumphed at turning the harshest truths into wildly exhilarating punk songs. On their second album *Happy Now*, vocalist/guitarist Nikki Sisti, vocalist/bassist Kate Black, and vocalist/drummer Shari Page deliver their most complex and confessional work yet, exploring everything from self-sabotage and insecurity to victim-blaming and destructive relationships. Raw, irreverent, and brutally honest, *Happy Now* ultimately offers both joyful catharsis and much-needed instruction for living well in turbulent times.

“Most of our songs lean toward optimism, even when there’s a lot of pain in them,” says Sisti, who refers to THICK’s output as a “living diary.” “It’s not about toxic positivity or trying to force yourself into happiness; it’s about recognizing that it’s okay to feel a whole spectrum of emotions, and then getting to the other side and really growing from your experiences.” The follow-up to *5 Years Behind* (a 2020 release praised by *Under the Rader* as a “dazzling debut album...laced with anger, humor, killer guitar riffs, and soaring punk melodies”), *Happy Now* finds THICK working again with producer Joel Hamilton (Iggy Pop, Juiceboxxx) and recording at Studio G Brooklyn. In a profound evolution of their previous work, the 11-track album encompasses sharper arrangements and stickier hooks and a more explosive energy—an effect often achieved through the sheer force of their three voices singing in unstoppable unison.



Kicking off with a glorious bang, *Happy Now* opens on the frenetic urgency of “Happiness”: a dizzying yet incisive track that sets THICK’s self-reflection to a fantastically breakneck rhythm. “That song’s about the different ways we seek validation, and how whether you look for it externally or internally, it’s never an easy process,” says Black. “In the end, it’s about being more aware of where we’re trying to find happiness.” With its brilliant back-and-forth between riotous shouting and impossibly sweet harmonies, “Loser” arrives as a thrilling celebration of hopeless imperfection, cleverly twisting its closing lyric into an unlikely mantra (“I’ll always be a loser”).

“Especially in music, it’s so easy to feel like a loser and a fuck-up,” says Page. “We want people to know that it’s okay to mess up and that everyone’s a loser sometimes. It’s really the best way to live, instead of trying to be number-one all the time.” And on “Tell Myself,” *Happy Now* slips into a wistful mood as THICK tenderly impart insight to their younger selves. “As you get older, you sometimes look at your little-kid self and wish you could give them a hug and tell them everything’s going to be okay,” says Black. “It’s not about minimizing life experiences, but a reminder that you’re stronger than you think and that—despite what it feels like in the moment—there is a light at the end of the tunnel.”



THICK

True to the egalitarian spirit of the band, THICK take a highly collaborative approach to their songwriting without ever sacrificing the intimacy of their lyrics. In the writing of the heavy-hearted “Disappear,” for instance, Sisti lifted directly from her journal in telling the story of “loving someone who gets lost in their own head, and how painful that can be.” Meanwhile, on “Her Chapstick,” Page opens up about a struggle in her own relationship. “It has to do with the experience of a partner seeking external affection,” she says. “It’s about navigating the feelings of why a partner is sharing themselves with someone else when you are right there.”

All New York State natives, THICK’s three members first crossed paths through shows at Brooklyn’s DIY/all-ages spaces and soon became a mainstay in that very scene. Since signing to Epitaph in 2018—and making their label debut with their self-titled third EP the following year—the band has dramatically expanded their reach and toured all over the country, including a 2021 run with punk legends Flogging Molly and Violent Femmes. But even as their fanbase grows exponentially, THICK thrive on forging an uncommonly close connection with their audience. “Getting to share our songs with new people and build community in places we’ve never been before has been the most fulfilling experience for us,” says Black. “We want to leave everyone smiling from ear to ear and get them moving around and hopefully look up at us and say, ‘Oh, I can do that. I’m gonna start my own band now.’”





Forest Fest is thrilled to welcome back The Tossers to the stage. One of the loved bands of 2022, they bring Irish Drinking Music for Punk Rockers with a touch of folk. The Tossers are an American six-piece Celtic punk band from Chicago, Illinois.





Formed in July 1993, they have toured with Murphy's Law, Streetlight, Dropkick Murphy's, The Reverend Horton Heat, Flogging Molly, Street Dogs and the Pogues.

The south side of Chicago has a tough working class reputation, it's also known for one of the largest populations of Irish people this side of the Emerald Isle. So it's not entirely incongruous that a hard luck kid from the south side of town would choose to play traditional Irish folk music in pubs around the neighborhood.

At 18, Anthony (T.) Duggins, was doing just that – playing pub favorites and covers of greats like Christy Moore, and Ewan MacColl. Before long his brother and his best friends were playing the original songs he had written as well, and so became The Tossers. The name was taken from an old slang term used for worthless British coins in Sean O'Casey's play *The Plough and the Stars*. The coins became useless after the southern Irish Free State won independence from Britain, and started to print it's own currency. The term tosser has since come to mean wanker, or it's American equivalent, jag off.

Forest Fest listened to your requests, and are thrilled to welcome back The Tossers to the stage. They put on a show that you won't want to miss.

Bad Cop Bad Cop

Bad Cop Bad Cop has done angry. The band's 2017 full-length, *Warriors*, was recorded in the aftermath of the 2016 presidential election. The Los Angeles quartet's new full-length, *The Ride* (Fat Wreck Chords, June 19th), shows what happens when you come out the other side of that anger.

"It's not that I am just stoked or blind to suffering," says singer-guitarist Jennie Cotterill. "I think anger is a legitimate and understandable reaction to injustice and wrongdoing. It's just that for myself, I am trying to move past 'reaction' into productive 'response.'"



The message BCBC is sending this time around is less about wagging your finger at others, or giving the middle one to the Man, than it is about self-love and acceptance. As Cotterill puts it, “Love is a more powerful truth than anger.” That positivity fuels many of The Ride’s tracks: “Originators,” “Simple Girl,” “Community,” “I Choose,” “Perpetual Motion Machine,” and “The Mirage” exude confidence, gratitude, and compassion. In 2020, such things qualify as contrarian.

“These are political statements—self-love is a huge fucking statement,” affirms singer-guitarist Stacey Dee. “Self-love means putting a fix on the problems at home before trying to fix everything in the world. It’s asking people to find it in themselves to create the life that they really want to have so they’re not in turmoil, so they’re not in a place of stress and sickness.”

Dee speaks from experience. In 2018 she was hospitalized twice for different ailments, then discovered she had stage one breast cancer at the end of the year. Fortunately it was highly treatable, but the experience was life-altering. Dee captures it with brutal frankness on “Breastless,” whose bright melodies belie the struggle described in the lyrics.

BAD COP / BAD COP

“Certain Kind of Monster” and “Pursuit of Liberty”—both written and sung by bassist Linh Le—are blistering repudiations of the governments treatment of immigrants.

The former is an imagined conversation with an ICE agent, and the latter juxtaposes her family’s immigration to the U.S. from Vietnam in 1975 to current events, something she’s never explored musically.

The perspective behind *The Ride* lends it an undeniable maturity, without losing its power. Recorded throughout much of 2018 and 2019 by Johnny Carey and Fat Mike of production team the D-Composers, the album boasts all of the elements of BCBC’s sound: big guitars, lock-step bass and drums (the latter by powerhouse drummer Myra Gallarza), intricate vocal harmonies, and plenty of attitude.

It’s just that this time, the attitude is encouraging, not raging. Nowhere is that more apparent than lilting album closer “Sing With Me.” Built around acoustic guitar, piano, and Cotterill’s voice, it’s an exhortation to “sing with me / or sing your own song / I don’t mind, just as long as you find / a voice.”



Dee adds, “If people are listening to our songs and they’re going to sing along to them, they’re going to start owning some of those words. And in owning some of those words that gives them some strength and power going forward. That’s really the biggest gift that I could give to anybody.”

“Stronger in every way” aptly describes Bad Cop Bad Cop in 2020. The anger may have taken a back seat on The Ride, but what’s taken its place is even more powerful.

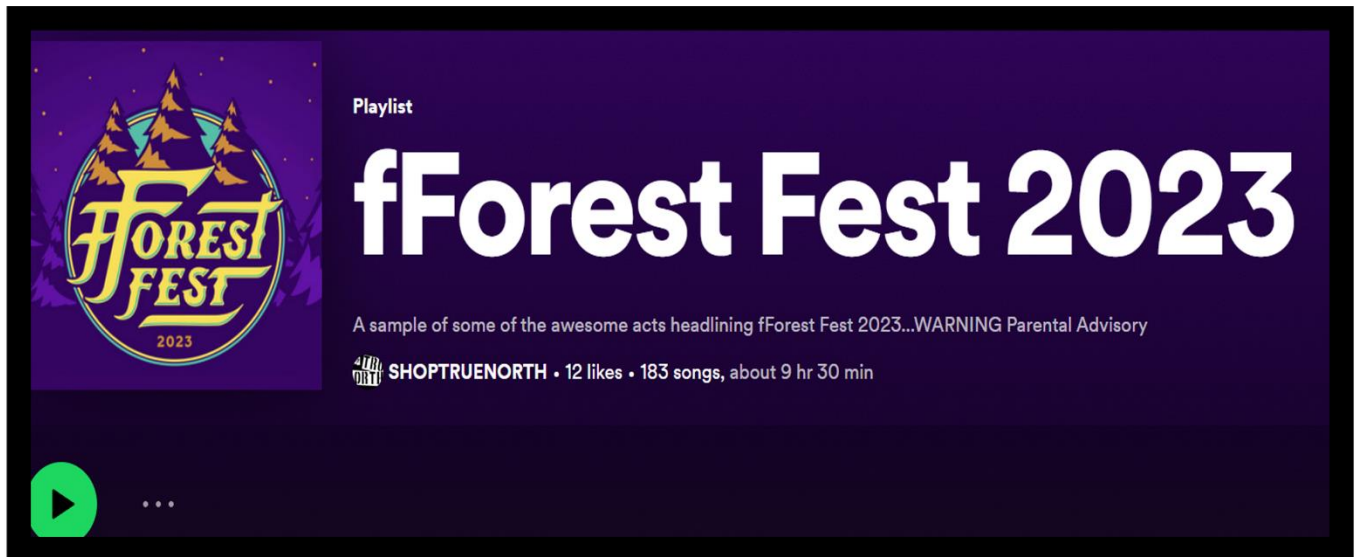

Frequently Asked Questions



FAQ: Can I bring a lawn chair?

Yes! We definitely welcome attendees to bring their own chairs or blankets. Be prepared to sit back and enjoy a day full of music and fun.



FAQ: Can leave, then come back?

Yes! You can leave and re-entry throughout the day as long as you still have on your wristband. Bring your bags to the car. Grab a chair. Run down the street to True North. No problem!



FAQ: Can I bring my pet?

No! Sorry. The City Ordinance is NO PETS in the park. Leave your dogs, cats, parrots and snakes at home. Thank you!



FAQ: How do I get tickets?

Tickets are available at the gate. Entry fee is \$10 person. Kids, ages 5 and under are free. Cash only. No tickets are sold ahead of the event. No early admission.

FAQ: Should I bring cash?

Yes! While some vendors may take creditcards, its best to bring cash. The internet gets overloaded and not every vendor will accept cards. Be prepared. You will need cash for the admission and beer.



FAQ: Is there an ATM?

Yes! There will be an ATM located near Gate One and the picnic pavilion. Don't spend your festival day waiting in line for cash... bring cash.



FAQ: Is this family friendly?

Yes! fForest Fest is a family friendly event. Kids of all ages are welcome. Bring your mom, your baby, your grandma, your best friend. Its a fun day for everyone!

FAQ: Is there handicapped parking?

Yes! Handicapped parking can be accessed in Lower Goold Park from Lisbon Street. The festival is held in a public park so there is uneven ground, however there is a paved path through part of the park.



FAQ: Can I bring alcohol?

No. Sorry there is no outside alcohol allowed in the park. There will be two locations to purchase a variety of beer, selters, mixed drinks and more. Thank you!



FAQ: Will band times be posted?

Yes! A pro tip is to save a photo of the band times on your phone. Take a screenshot of the set times in this event guide or on the web site: www.fforestfest.com.

FAQ: Will the bands be selling merch?

Yes! Most will. Look for the Merch Tent to the north of the Stage, near Gate Three. You may even catch the bands hanging out there before or after their sets.



FAQ: Can I buy festival merch?

Yes! Definitely! Look for the Merch Tent. There are t-shirts, koozies, stickers, posters and more. The Merch tent does accept credit cards. Tip: there is a limited number of festival posters available. Shop early.



FAQ: Will the festival cancel for weather?

Nope. The show goes on rain or shine, or wind or snow. (You never know!). We always hope for a nice sunny day, but we haven't yet figured out how to control the weather. All we can do is ask attendees to please show up no matter the weather. A lot goes into producing a festival of this size. Our vendors spend time planning, our bands travel long distances, and the food is still being prepared. So, we all hope you will show up and support fForest Fest - whatever the weather has in store.



FAQ: Is there a kids discount?

Yes! Kids ages 5 and under are free to attend. fFest Friends in Upper Gould Park is free to attend. Ages 85 and over are free also, with proof of age.



PARKING

Follow the signs to fForest Fest for parking.

Park on any of the side streets surrounding the festival. Watch for 'no parking' signs and do not block driveways.

There is limited parking available in upper Goold Park, enter from Union Street.

The Morris Community High School is graciously allowing fForest Fest to use their lot for the event. Again, enter from Union Street.

Some handicapped spaces are available near Gate Two, available on a first come basis. Enter from Lisbon Street.

Remember, you can go back to your car if needed as long as you keep on your wristband.
